PRE-K REGISTRATION

Hurray for Pre-K! Beginning in January pre-kindergarten will be full day. We will have registration for new pre-k students Tuesday, November 12th from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. To be eligible for the pre-kindergarten program, your child must have turned 4 years of age by September 1, 2019 and meet an eligibility requirement as determined by Texas law. No exceptions can be made. This program is for Limited English Proficiency students, economically disadvantage students, homeless students, foster students or a student whose parent or guardian in an active duty member of the Armed Forces of the United States. A student must be present at the time of registration to determine, through testing, if they will qualify for the program. To register, parents must provide the school with the following items:



- a certified copy of the child's birth certificate from the Bureau of Vital Statistics (see City of Houston Bureau of Vital Statistics to obtain a birth certificate if born in the city of Houston)
- a current immunization record
- a proof of residency (example: lease agreement or utility bill)
- a social security card for each child, if available.
- a parent /guardian identification
- proof of income
